

Protection of personal data

Information provided pursuant to Article 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (General Data Protection Regulation – GDPR) concerning the processing of personal data of ADULT and/or MINOR USERS of the EDUCATIONAL PARK.

Data Controller.

The Data Controller is SINERGIA OUTDOOR, located at Località Sigola Alta, 36, 12040 - Baldissero d'Alba (CN), Italy.

Purposes and legal basis for processing.

Personal data will be processed for the purposes outlined below, in accordance with the specified legal bases and retention periods:

Data processing will always be based on principles of fairness, lawfulness, transparency and protection of the privacy and rights of the data subjects.

Recipients of data. Personal data will be processed by the Data Controller and by personnel who are duly authorised and trained. Data may be disclosed to the following categories of third parties:

CATEGORIES OF THIRD PARTIES TO WHOM DATA OR PART OF DATA MAY BE COMMUNICATED
Consultants and professionals, including in associated form, who must carry out assignments on behalf of the Controller
Public bodies (legal communication to competent entities: Revenue Agency, etc...)
Competent authorities of Judicial Police and Public Security for investigative purposes, detection and prosecution of offences

- **Rights of data subjects.** Data subjects have the right to request access to their personal data, as well as its rectification, erasure, restriction of processing, and data portability, in accordance with Articles 15–20 of European Regulation 2016/679 which may be exercised at any time by sending a request via email to info@sinergiaoutdoor.com.

Data subjects also have the right to object to processing based on the Data Controller's legitimate interests, pursuant to Article 21 of the GDPR. However, the Controller may reject the request if they demonstrate compelling legitimate grounds to proceed with the processing.

- **Right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority.** Data subjects may lodge a complaint with the competent Supervisory Authority. In Italy, this is the Garante per la Protezione dei Dati Personali: www.garanteprivacy.it.

- **Existence of automated decision-making.** No automated decision-making processes are used in the processing of personal data.

- **Transfer of data to a third country or international organisation.** Personal data will not be transferred to non-EU countries or international organisations.
